

Directive 2002/95/EC of the European parliament and of the council of 27 January 2003 on Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

Since July 1, 2006, this copper semi-finished product of GINDRE group contain only little traces of cadmium and lead, among the substances listed by the Directive.

There is no mercury, no hexavalent chromium, no PBB and no PBDE.

Consequently our products are in conformance with the RoHS directive.

The lead quantity is very low. The maximal quantity authorized is 50 ppm (EN 1976 standard), equivalent to 50 g for 1000 kg of copper.

The Cadmium quantity is lower. It is between 0.1 ppm, (0.1 g for 1000 kg of copper) and 0.5 ppm, (also regarding the EN 1976 Standard). We remind you that annex 5 and 6 of 2002/95/CE directive (part of RoHS directives) allows the use of lead until 4% of copper weight. (40 000 ppm) See articles 4-1 and 4-2.

Moreover, we respect all the regulations applicable in our activity and attach a great importance to the raw materials we supply.

Otherwise, our copper products are completely recyclable.
